

Charter

FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF THE

Arizona Chapter

OF

The American Society of Heating and Ventilating Engineers

1. This Chapter is established for the purpose of advancing the arts and sciences of heating, ventilating, cooling and air conditioning, and the allied arts and sciences.
2. This Chapter shall be governed by the provisions of the Society's Certificate of Incorporation and By-Laws, the Rules promulgated by the Council in harmony therewith, and any amendments to the foregoing.
3. Only members of the Society in good standing, residing in the vicinity of this Chapter's headquarters, shall be eligible to become and remain members of this Chapter.
4. This Charter is revocable by action of the Council taken pursuant to the Society's By-Laws and Rules.
